2 Minutes of last Forum meeting (2/11/17) and Matters Arising

3. Themed Presentation and Group Discussion

Emilia Cozma from Citizens Advice Witness Service gave a presentation on the service. The key points were:

- The service is available in every court, matching witnesses with court-based volunteers. Over 280 support 2,800 volunteers
- Over 170,000 witnesses are supported each year.
- Witnesses can self-refer (0300 33 21 000) as well as both the prosecution and defence (0300 233 21 000)
- The outreach service is relatively new, but offers a more supportive service for some people.

BAF PROJECTS - UPDATE REPORT

BAF training

BAF's 2017 training programme was very successful.

- 4 courses 2 x Benefits Update and 2 x Universal Credit
- 44 attendees
- Very positive feedback 100% of attendees on all 4 courses said that the course fulfilled their expectations, and that the trainers and course delivery was very good
- 3 agencies joined BAF when making bookings for the training.
- A surplus of £667.14 was made from the programme

It is planned to organise further training courses in 2018. The suggestions are:

- Introduction to Benefits Early summer 2018
- Universal Credit Autumn 2018
- Disability benefits TBC

Advice Strategy - Central Bedfordshire
