Who is part of the VOCypf network?

The **VOCypf** in Bedford Borough and Central Bedfordshire comprises a broad range of organisations including:

- Research, campaigning and training providers working at a local, regional and national level eg Family Matters Institute
- Larger organisations delivering countywide services commissioned by local authorities and/or NHS eg Brooke, Mind,
- Children Centres eg Goldington Family Centre, The Children Society, 4Children
- Specialist services eg Chums, Plan B, Sorted, Open Door, Relate, Ormiston Trust
- Services for children with disabilities eg Autism Beds, Mencap, Bedford Society For Cerebral Palsy, Family United Network
- Organisations delivering specialist services for young people eg Youth Matters, Great Outdoors, Xers, YMCA, DevelopEBP
- Faith Groups offering support and activities for children and young people eg Salvation Army, Priory Methodist Church, Santosh Refuge
- Uniform Groups such as scouts, guides etc who operate locally but are connected with national federations.
- Community Projects these can be time limited or on-going
- Sports and Activity Clubs eg NACRO, Viking Kayak Club
